BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR COMPETITION – SATURDAY

Best Bred by Exhibitor will be awarded from the First Place winners in the Bred by Exhibitor Puppy & Adult Classes immediately following each breed/variety. If the Best of Winners or Best of Breed/Variety is awarded to a dog/bitch coming from the Bred by Exhibitor Class, then the Best Bred by Exhibitor for that breed/variety is automatic. All Best Bred by Exhibitor Winners will then compete in their respective group for First through Fourth. The first place winners of the Bred by Exhibitor Group Competition will then compete for Best Bred by Exhibitor in Show. Bred by Exhibitor Group Judges will be announced at the show.

RAMP – The following breeds must be examined on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Lagotto Romagnolo, Clumber Spaniel, Sussex Spaniel, Basset Hound, Cirneco dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terrier, Bulldog, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chow, Keeshond, Spanish Water Dog.

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be examined on a ramp through all levels of competition: Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever, American Water Spaniel, Boykin Spaniels, English Springer Spaniel, Field Spaniel, Welsh Springer Spaniel, Basenji, Grand Basset Griffon Vendeen, Whippet, German Pinscher, Portuguese Water Dog, Standard Schnauzer, American Staffordshire Terrier, Irish Terrier, Soft Coated Wheaten Terrier, Staffordshire Bull Terrier, Finnish Spitz, Australian Cattle Dogs, Entlebucher Mountain Dog, Finnish Lapphund, Icelandic Sheepdog, Mudi, Norwegian Buhund, Polish Lowland Sheepdog, Puli, Norrbottenspet.

The following breeds may be examined on the ground, table or ramp: Miniature Bull Terrier. Junior showmanship judges should follow the above.

Ramps may be used in emergency situations to examine any breed. (In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.) 10/1/25

Stud Dog Class - For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the get. The owner of the stud dog need not be the owner of the get. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class, will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his get and be entered in the Stud Dog Class.

Brood Bitch Class - For bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not be the owner of the produce. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merit of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with her produce and be entered in the Brood Bitch Class.

National Owner Handled Series

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Bestof Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled group.
- o If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- o If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of thesame sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the
 judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as
 Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winner is ineligible since it was defeated.
 - o No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners competition.

Regulations

Section 1- Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 ofthe *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Section 2 - Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed or member dog shows at the option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- Closing date and time for this competition may be listed as any date and time prior to the event including the same day as the event and must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.

Ribbons for Groups and Best Four to Six Puppy in Show will be as follows: Best of Breed – Orange; Best of Opposite Sex – Lavender Best 4-6 Month Puppy in Show – Pink & Green

- 1. Entries must reach the Superintendent, Jack Bradshaw by Noon, Wednesday October 15, 2025 PT or by the limit. Fees should accompany entries. This club and/or its superintendent assume no responsibility for wrong or incompleteinformation given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This club and its superintendents assume noresponsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or forentering the same dog twice.
- 2. Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount ofeach returned check and declined credit card. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in theirbeing put on a cash only basis. The returned check or declined credit card must be made good by cash or money orderbefore the dog will be allowed in the ring.
- 3. Exhibitors' confirmations and judging programs will be emailed to the email address on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the superintendent.
- 4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, In order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not neededfor further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at theentrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in ajudging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is accourtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class after the closing of entries may transfer their entry to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the Show, whichever is earlier.
- 16. Dogs which according to their owners' records have earned an obedience or rally title after the closing of entriesfor the show may be moved up to the next class, provided this transfer is made in writing and presented to the superintendent at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
- 17. No practicing is allowed in rings at any time.
- 18. Parents and/or Guardians are responsible for the actions of their children.
- 19. Bitches in season are ineligible to compete in trials. To receive a refund, a veterinarian's letter needs to be received by the Superintendent no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. There will be a \$4.00 fee charged for bitch in season cancellations
- 20. Electricity is not available anywhere on the grounds. Personal generators, properly muffled, may be used in the reserved grooming areas and the free grooming area on the West side of the grounds. No personal generators will be allowed within the show area which includes the area along the hedge row. No exhibitor is allowed to plug-in to bait nuts, farm electrical outlets.
- 21. No x-pens are allowed under any Club provided tents..
- 22. This is self cleaning events, you are required to keep their area clean.
